

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

For the Asbestos Enrollment Survey

The Clean Classrooms for Carolina Kids™ asbestos section may require you provide documentation to our program to help us determine the next steps for your facility.

The documentation you are prompted to provide in the enrollment survey will depend on your facility's building age and prior asbestos inspection history.



PRIOR INSPECTION



Asbestos Inspection Report

If you indicate that your facility has already been inspected for asbestos by a NC-accredited asbestos inspector, you will be asked to provide your most recent inspection report. The inspector should provide a report on the inspection identifying the following information about the asbestos-containing material (at minimum):

- Type
- Location
- Condition
- Amount
- Recommended Response Actions



Mitigation/Abatement Records

If you indicate that your facility mitigated/abated any asbestos-containing materials during the last three years (i.e. removals, repairs, enclosures, encapsulations), you will be asked to provide these documents to RTI.

BUILDING AGE EXEMPTION



Property Tax Record or Signed Statement

Your child care facility can be exempt from the asbestos inspection if:

- The licensed child care facility produces a property tax record that shows the building occupied by the licensed child care facility was built after October 12, 1988.

OR

- An architect or project engineer responsible for the construction of a new facility built after October 12, 1988, or an accredited inspector, signs a statement that no asbestos was specified or used in the construction of the building(s).

PROPERTY TAX RECORD – ALL CHILD CARE FACILITIES



Property Tax Record

All child care facilities will be asked to provide a property tax record. A link to your county's tax record map where you can search for your address will be provided.

The property tax record must clearly display:

- The address
- The year your facility was built

If you have trouble finding your property tax document, you can request assistance from our staff. Please note that this will cause a delay in the process and may require additional communication.
