



# When is Lead-Based Paint On-Site Visit Needed?

This guide explains the possible recommended actions for a facility based on the responses and documentation provided in the enrollment survey.

# LEAD RISK ASSESSMENT

A lead risk assessment may be required if either of the following apply:

- Facility was built after 1978 but **cannot attest** that no lead-based paint was used in any building.
- Facility **has not had** a lead risk assessment.
- Facility's prior lead risk assessment was not within the past 3 years.
- Facility's prior lead risk assessment was not performed in accordance with <u>40 CFR 745.223</u> and <u>10A</u> NCAC 41C .0800 and .0900.
- Facility **did not provide documentation** of their prior lead risk assessment.

# LEAD SITE VERIFICATION

A lead site verification may be required if the following applies:

- Facility's prior lead risk assessment was completed within the past 3 years and meets the rule requirements, but:
  - The risk assessment identified **lead-based paint hazards** and <u>no</u> **documentation** was provided to show the hazards have been mitigated.

### LEAD EXEMPTION

A lead exemption will be issued if either of following apply:

### **Building Age Exemption**

Facility provides a signed **lead-based paintfree attestation** that states **all buildings** at the facility were **built after 1978** and no lead-based paint was used in any buildings.

### Prior Inspection Exemption

- Facility provides documentation of a prior lead risk assessment that meets all the following criteria:
  - The lead risk assessment was completed within the **past 3 years**.
  - The lead risk assessment was performed in accordance with <u>40</u> <u>CFR 745.223</u> and <u>10A NCAC 41C .0800 and .0900</u>.
  - The lead risk assessment identified **no lead-based paint hazards** OR **mitigation records** are provided to show these hazards have been addressed.
